Product Summary

UK Police Locations is a data pack containing location information for 1,300 police stations and contact points in England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, along with operational boundaries for each police force. The data pack has been designed primarily for thematic mapping and to support analysis of crime statistics.

Data quality statement

Details of individual police stations and contact points were collected from UK police force websites in September 2016 or later. All identified police locations have been assigned coordinates using open data from Ordnance Survey and ONS. For most locations the geocoding is the postcode centroid and will be geographically close but not specific to the site address. However all force headquarters, as well as all locations in Northern Ireland, have been manually geocoded to the premises.

Addresses have not been matched or validated against PAF or any other thirdparty address dataset. Datadaptive has taken reasonable care to standardise the data and correct errors where apparent, but the accuracy and currency of the data is dependent on the input sources. In particular please note that a significant number of police stations have been closed to the public in recent years and some forces may not publicise all of their operational locations.

Data formats

Tabular data is normally supplied in CSV format, suitable for use in Excel and other common spreadsheet programmes. Spatial data is normally supplied in unstyled ESRI Shapefile format with the WGS84 projection. However we are happy to supply the data in other suitable formats.

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Licensing

Supply of the data pack is subject to our standard <u>notice for supply of added</u> <u>value open licensed data products</u>. Once supplied the data may be re-used under the <u>Creative Commons Attribution License 4.0</u> (CC-BY). CC-BY is an <u>open data</u> licence that allows almost unrestricted re-use of the data. CC-BY is perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive, and interoperable with the <u>Open</u> <u>Government Licence</u>.






